Keeping a border collie is not an inexpensive venture, between quality food, veterinary care, and training. Are you confident that you know how much this dog will cost you to maintain and that you have the resources to do so?

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We require all buyers to have their dog, once it is two years of age, tested for the various **genetic diseases** that border collies are susceptible to, including OFA or PennHIP x-rays for hip and elbow dysplasia, and examinations by a board-certified veterinary ophthalmologist for eye problems. These tests can cost upwards of \$700, depending upon your area.

- o Will you ensure that your dog has this testing done between 24 and 30 months of age?
- O Do you understand that you must pay for these tests?
- Do you understand that our warranty is contingent upon the completion of this testing by 30 months of age?
- o Do you agree to provide the test results to us?

We also ask each owner to participate in the University of Pennsylvania's Canine Behavioral Assessment Research Questionnaire C-BARQ (http://vetapps.vet.upenn.edu/cbarq/) at a minimum of 1 and 4 years of age. There is no cost to this participation but it requires completing a 10-15 minute on-line questionnaire. Are you willing to participate in our C-BARQ program?
